Inspector's Note:
Boiler Business



Veterans Day
November 11, 2019



The cooler weather is here and you're probably getting ready to turn on the heat in your units. If you use a boiler system in a property with 6 or more units, according to the State of Ohio Department of Commerce, an annual boiler inspection is required. Inspections can only be conducted by the State and State approved inspectors. HCV Inspectors verify those inspections by checking that boilers have a metallic tag and an orange sticker displayed. If information is current and displayed the boiler will pass. If you need to schedule a boiler inspection, call 614-644-2223.

The debut of the new software system has been pushed back to early 2020 and that means you have more time to retrieve any information you need from the current Partner Portal. As a reminder, Cincinnati Metropolitan Housing Authority is transitioning to a new software system called Yardi. To allow for additional staff training and improved efficiency, the switch for the Housing Choice Voucher Program takes place February 1, 2020. During this transition you are encouraged to access the current portal and collect information you need and want to save for your records especially documents for tax purposes and historical purposes. When the system goes live, you will have a limited amount of time to view the current portal. Information about participants, units and much more will be stored on Yardi. A quick peak at the system will be provided at the Landlord Appreciation Banquet. More in-depth training opportunities of the new portal will be held on dates to be determined. You are encouraged to attend at least one of those trainings.



Do You Know: The Housing Choice Voucher Program partners with the Cincinnati VA? The partnership with the VA was formed to help Veterans who struggle with housing. This collaboration provides Veterans with housing vouchers and VA supportive services such as health care, mental health treatment and substance use counseling. It is best known as the HUD VASH program and it helps Veterans in their recovery process and with their ability to maintain housing in the community.
