This is a public opening bid at the date and time the bids are due. At that time the proposals will be read aloud and CMHA staff will begin the due diligence to determine the responsiveness of the lowest bid. The results of the bid will be posted on CMHA website when the diligence is complete.

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g. Ref. sheet S100 (drawings) The plan calls for the soil nail/shotcrete wall to extend 18" below the existing stone wall, there are remnants of an old concrete foundation butted up against the wall, our recommendation is to leave this in place and terminate against it or has permission been given to remove this? Without knowing the details of this old foundation, it may be integrated with the stone retaining wall, making it impossible to remove without damaging the stone wall.

h. Ref. sheet S100 (drawings), there are 3 trees to be removed and stumps grinded down 12" below grade, the trees are embedded in the wall and can be removed however grinding the stumps should not be done.
