
The Beechwood RAD Updates

The Beechwood RAD project is continuing with renovation work on floors 10-13. Crews are working on asbestos mitigation and the demolition of cabinets. Appliances have been removed from the units on these floors, and plumbers have begun removing bathroom fixtures. The popcorn ceiling finish has also been removed on floor 13!

Mechanical vacuum equipment is being used during demolition to maintain negative air pressure in areas being worked on. This is to prevent the spread of contaminants like dust, asbestos, and mold spores from the demolition area into surrounding areas to keep the construction crew, CMHA employees, and residents on the lower floors safe.







RENT BOST APPROVED

Maple Towers was approved for a rental subsidy boost of \$100 per unit! While resident rent rates will remain the same, CMHA will now be eligible to receive an extra \$100 per unit in subsidized funding through HUD. This is great news as CMHA will be able to "raise rent" while still ensuring residents are not affected by the increase!
